

ROLES & STRUCTURES



THE ROLES

We are seeking to recruit Council Members to represent in one of the following areas of the game:

- Senior Clubs
- Recreational Football
- Coaching
- Disability Football
- Adult Players 11v11

COMMITMENT

The term limit for each role is a maximum of 3 x 3 years with the option to extend for a further 3 years. The Articles of the Association state the applicant must reside in the Bedfordshire area and be under the age of 70.

Successful applicants will be required to attend 3 Council meetings a year and will be nominated onto a committee. The roles are voluntary; all traveling expenses are paid at the standard rate agreed by the Board.

APPLICATION PROCESS

We know that applying for roles can be time consuming, so we've made our application process as simple as possible. All we need from you at this stage is two things:

- A cover letter explaining why you wish to apply and why you think you are suitable
- A copy of your CV

APPLICATION PROCESS

- Attach your cover letter and CV

INTERVIEWS

- Shortlisted candidates will be asked to attend an interview within 2 weeks of the application closing date.

SELECTION

- Candidates will be notified of the outcome following their interview. In line with good Governance practice, we may ask for references, further information & declaration

INDUCTION

All Council Members will be provided with Beds FA kit and tie. They will also be invited to attend a formal induction with the Chair & CEO
