PREMIER LEAGUE DEFIBRILLATOR FUND Funded by Premier C League Defivered by Football Foundation

Premier League Defibrillator Fund

The Premier League Defibrillator Fund will support the installation of Automated External Defibrillators (AEDs) and External Storage Cabinets at thousands of grassroots football facilities currently without an easily accessible device on site.

Rolled out across two phases, the Fund will see more than 2000 sites benefit from this investment with the first 1,000 units delivered in time for the start of the 2021/22 season and the second wave expected in September. Once installed, the AEDs will be accessible, if required, to an estimated 1.5m people that use these facilities per season.

Going forward, the Premier League is working with partners at The FA and Sport England to ensure that facilities funded by the Football Foundation incorporate this equipment in the future.



Referees



In order to appropriately support our Futsal events starting on Sunday 24th October, we are hosting a Futsal Referee Course at Northstowe Secondary College on Sunday 28th November 2021.

Places are open to individuals who are readily available on Sunday PM's to officiate at Futsal Events in Northstowe, Swavesey and at Cambridge University and over the age of 14. Individuals do not have to be a current/active FA Referee to complete the Futsal Referee Qualification.

Booking your place:

Booking opens from Monday 25th October 2021 for all individuals within Cambridgeshire FA boundaries, with any remaining places opening on Wednesday 17th November 2021. You can <u>express your interest in the course here</u>. Completion of the Expression of Interest form is required in order to receive the booking link.

Course Cost

The cost of the course is £80.00 per candidate. Candidates will receive appropriate Refereeing Equipment, DBS Check (for those over 16 and who do not have an in date FA DBS) and Futsal Referee Qualification. Individuals will be required to hold an in date Safeguarding Qualification. If this is required, then an additional cost of £30.00 is necessary.

Our FA Referee Course are back up and running under a different guise. The course now features online learning plus 11 hours of contact time in the form of 1 evening session and a Sunday day.

In order to sign up for a course the process has also changed due to the pre-required online learning.

Learners are now required to complete the steps outlined below, following this, details to book the place will be provided.

Please note that learners places are not confirmed until Stage 4 has been completed and you have booked on through the provided booking link. For the online learning sections, please ensure these are completed on the candidates (the individual that wishes to attend the course) account.
