
ANTHONY TAYLOR HEADS TO UEFA EURO 20

CHESHIRE WEST AND CHESTER RECEIVED A FOOTBALL FOUNDATION GRANT TO SUPPORT THE DEVELOPMENT OF A 3G FOOTBALL TURF PITCH AND CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW TWO-TEAM CHANGING PAVILION. THE DEVELOPMENT WAS COMPLETED IN OCTOBER 2021 AND IS NOW OPEN.

FRODSHAM JUNIORS FC ARE THE PARTNER CLUB ON SITE AND THE PITCH WILL BENEFIT LOCAL RESIDENTS AND PUPILS AT HELSBY HIGH SCHOOL ENSURING A HIGH QUALITY PLAYING ENVIRONMENT. PLAYERS WILL NOW BE ABLE TO ENJOY THE NEW ALL-WEATHER PITCH, NEW CHANGING PAVILION AND IMPROVEMENTS TO THE GRASS PITCHES, WHICH WILL REPRESENT A SIGNIFICANT IMPROVEMENT ON THE EXISTING GRASS PITCHES, WHICH ARE PRONE TO BECOMING WATERLOGGED AND IN NEED OF RENOVATION.


