MINCE PIES AND MENTORING EVENT CELEBRATES YEAR OF SUCCESS

The final FA Coach Mentor 'Female Game' CPD event of the year took place on Monday 17th December at the Cornwall FA office. With the theme of 'Mince Pies & mentoring' the evening gave the opportunity to review the programme so far, bringing together like minded coaches to share their ideas and experiences.

Coaches were grouped to allow specific outcomes based on the ages and needs of the players they are working with. With three working groups tasks were based on working with beginner girls, what are their needs and how can we support them. Group 2 looked at key themes of the game including build & retain, progress and penetrate and create and score. These were mapped onto areas of the pitch and then broken down to consider the key technical components of each theme to create session topics and focuses. The final group looked at player profiling based on the 11 a side game, using the four corner model to identify attributes and traits of players based upon position.

Following group tasks the coaches then helped shape the design of the programme moving forward into the New Year choosing CPD topic themes based on their own needs. Throughout 2018 the female game mentoring programme has engaged with nearly 40 coaches and continues to grow with every event, it's always great to meet with new coaches and this event was no different.

Delivered by FA Coach Mentors Natasha Mills and Vicky Fisher the programme is open to all female coaches in Cornwall along with any coach working within the female / women's game or with an interest in doing so. Along with regular CPD events the coach mentors also offer individual support to coaches within their own club environments. Bude and St. Agnes also play within the SWWFL, a division below Callington in the Western division. Bude go into the New Year in 7th place in their second season back in the SWWFL. St. Agnes took promotion this year and have faced a tough challenge with their results not always reflecting their performances. However it's been great to see the club embracing the opportunity and expanding to run two teams to ensure an opportunity for all squad members by also having a team playing the Cornwall Womens League.

The Cornwall Womens league grew again this year and made a positive decision to split the league into two divisions. This has resulted in some fantastic competitive matches and although the divisions are currently small the opportunity to play in county cup and league cup competitions allow the opportunity for further competition and challenges. The league welcomed FXU as a new team and Newquay who have returned to play in the Cornwall Womens League after several seasons in the South West League. The league looks set to grow again next season with youth players reaching an age to play Womens football and further new teams being created. A huge thank you to all the coaches, managers, volunteers and those on the league committees give up their time to ensure the leagues to operate every week. I have enjoyed watching some of the games and will be out again in the New Year to see some more action!


Your poster will feature on the new page and needs to include:
