The first half of the day included various coaching sessions delivered by experienced coaches Natasha Mills and Beth Willshaw along with Youth Council member Mollie Dring. The players showed excellent skills and team work throughout the sessions and kept the coaches on their toes with lots of great questions and new ideas to try. The afternoon then saw all players mixing together in teams and competing in fast paced, small sided games. Each player was able to try out different positions and implement some of the skills that were practised in the earlier sessions. The great effort and sportsmanship on display was truly impressive. This helped create a really positive environment in which everyone involved could try their best, learn new skills and make new friends within fun matches.

We would like to say a big thank you to the schools that attended and made the day a success. Also to the coaches and referees who supported the festival throughout the day. We look forward to running similar events in the future where we hope to see even more schools and young people get involved.

Temporary Dismissal (Sin Bin) Training Events Confirmed

From the start of the 2019/20 season The FA have stated that the use of Temporary Dismissals (Sin Bins) will be used across all leagues that operate at Step 5 of the National Football League System and below, this includes all Saturday, Sunday, Veterans, Women's and Youth Leagues and Competitions that are affiliated to or sanctioned by Cornwall FA or The FA.

Training for all clubs, leagues and referees will be delivered across Cornwall over the next few months by Governance Manager Richard Pallot and our Referees Workforce Officer Stuart Kane, there will also be Webex (video conference) training run by The FA. 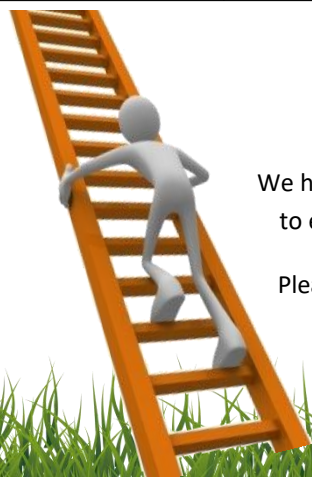

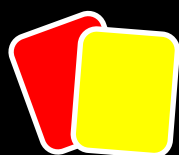

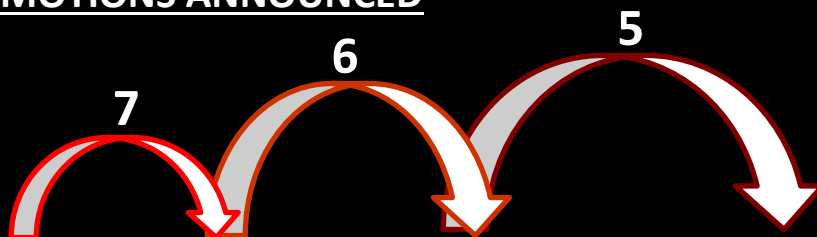
