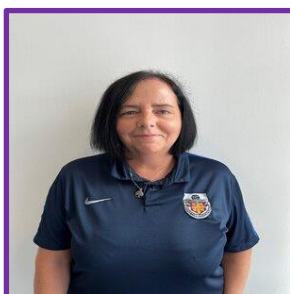

Discipline

Submitting discipline is an important role of a match official and this can be easily done through the Whole Game System (WGS)

It is important any reports are submitted with 48hrs of the game so that any discipline can be processed.

When carrying out your duties as a referee please ensure that when you caution, dismiss or report any participants that you get their full name at the time rather than rely on any team sheets or websites.

Any offences by managers, coaches or spectators/any discrimination or any incidents outside of a normal caution/dismissal need to be reported as any extraordinary report on the WGS.

Referee Promotion Pathway

The referee promotion pathway was revised by the FA in season 22/23 which would benefit match officials in that it no longer became a seasonal window.

Instead promotions can now run over into new seasons and is split into 4 opportunities to join or be promoted during a season.
