Coach Transition Programme

Are you currently a Level 1 or Level 2 coach?
 Have you considered or would you consider doing your next FA coaching qualification (Level 2 or Level 3)?

The FA Women's High Performance Football Centre at Northumbria University, in partnership with Northumberland FA and Durham FA, is launching the Coach Transition Programme (CTP) to support coaches' progression towards their next step on The FA Coach Education Pathway.

Aimed at those coaching in the female game (male or female coaches) or females coaching across any format of the game (male or female football), the CTP will provide bespoke support to help develop both coaching confidence and coaching competence.

Structured across the course of the 19/20 season, the CTP will involve 7 coach development 'touch points' that will incorporate a mixture of workshops, practical delivery, match observations and session observations. The programme content and structure is below:

Successful applicants who gain a place on the programme will be able to access a £100 bursary to be used towards their next level of coaching qualification (Level 2 or Level 3)

 be accessed at any point during this 2 year period.
- Coaches must attend minimum of 5 out of 7 touch points, with the Programme Induction & Programme Review being mandatory as part of the 5. Please note: we would encourage attendance at all 7 touch points to maximise impact on your coaching.
 Dates for the Programme Induction and Programme Review are specified with all other events falling in the month stated, with

specific dates for these will being confirmed on an going basis.
