

Manager's Comment

Manager's Comment

After gaining promotion in the Bristol & District leagues for 2 consecutive seasons, we set ourselves the target of trying to push for a 3rd promotion and a decent cup run, as we had failed to make it past the 2nd round in previous seasons.

The 1st half of the season was commendable with 6 wins, 1 draw and 2 loses in the league, whilst progressing to the 3rd round of the cup, a first since the A's had started, History had been made! An additional positive at the time for the A's as well as the club, was being able to field 16 players most weeks due to player availability being good throughout the club. The 2nd half of season started well with us progressing to the semifinals of the cup and competing at the top of the league.

The pressure was on for the remainder of the season, and it could have ended early in February with our semifinal match and league match against the league leaders within the space of 7 days! Fortunately, we were comfortably able to secure our place in the final along with taking 3 points in a more competitive match a week later. However in the penultimate end of the season we've had some poor results which we could easily blame on poor availability which has struck the club in the last few weeks but the squads we've picked have been more than capable of getting the results needed and us the management team and the players that have played have to take responsibility for that.

Nonetheless, we now have a cup final to focus on with the hope of ending the club's 12-year silverware drought with a big win on April 8th.
