Manager's Comment

Barnwood United have undergone a near-miraculous transformation in performance and results from the 2023-24 to the 2024-25 season, across all senior sides, including the Reserves. This turnaround has been driven by several factors: new facilities, an influx of players, growing confidence, and belief.

The club now has a true home for the first time in its 45-year history, thanks to modern facilities at Coopes Edge—secured through an outstanding tender response to Tewkesbury Borough Council, led by Chris Coward, Rob Sherwood, and James Culley. These upgrades include new changing rooms, official facilities, floodlit 4G five-a-side training, a floodlit MUGA, and improved pitches. These enhancements have attracted new players, revitalizing both senior and youth teams.

The Reserves, in particular, have flourished, now eyeing league promotion and having reached the SDFL League Cup semi-final and this County Cup final. While new signings have been pivotal, the determination and resilience of long-standing players, who endured the club's toughest years, have been equally crucial.

The road to the final has been anything but easy, featuring a dramatic comeback against Horsley Reserves, a penalty shootout victory over Trident, and hard-fought wins against Longlevens and others. The semi-final saw a game-changing performance from Aldi Kaci, securing the club's first cup final in over a decade.
