Clubs wishing to enter a team into the GFA Challenge Trophy are reminded of the qualifying pitch and facility requirements:-

- Maximum length: 110 metres. Minimum Length: 100 metres
- Maximum width: 75 metres Minimum width: 64 metres
- Dressing and washing accommodation must be separate for each team and Match Officials. They must have heating and hot water and be cleaned and maintained to a satisfactory standard.
- The playing area must be enclosed by a permanent fixed barrier on all four sides and may be in-filled with advertisement hoardings or other barriers.

* As there is no County Cup competition at this level, Senior Professional Clubs are invited to enter a Reserve, U23 or U21 team in the Senior Challenge Cup competition.

The final decision on any team's Cup entry is made by the GFA Cups Committees once all entries are received.
