STEP 1

Manage clubs and teams

Make sure your club's records are up-to-date.

All affiliated teams are present and correct, fold any teams if necessary.



STEP 2

Manage Team Officials

Make sure the right coaches and officials are against the right teams.

Anyone in red means their CRC or qualifications are missing or out of date. Those in amber mean the above are due to expire.



STEP 3

Club action plan

Leave comments against any criteria you do not yet satisfy and what your plan of action is before you submit your application.







FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

When will a County award my club's Annual Health Check?

After submission County FAs will award your health check if they are satisfied with your action plan, such as coaches being booked onto relevant courses, or if all criteria is satisfied.

Health checks will be rejected if the relevant officials do not hold a CRC and appropriate safeguarding qualifications.

When will my club receive our rewards for completing the process?

A digital certificate and promotional materials are sent within a few weeks to the main club contact once awarded.

Physical rewards such as footballs are distributed in time for the following season.

Do the rewards my club receives vary and change each season?
