Below you can find a brief description of roles and where they are likely to be based (Suggested locations are flexible and confirmed locations will have some flexibility). On the following page you will find the core skills, experiences, roles, and responsibilities which are required of you regardless of which of the roles you choose.

Dependant on your chosen role you will either be reporting into Football Development Manager, Adult Male Football Development Officer, Women & Girls Football Development Officer, Marketing & PR Manager, Stoneham Lane Football Complex Centre Manager or Community Engagement & Inclusion Officer.

The following statements should give you a flavour of what each role entails and what is expected of you if you once you have chosen a specific area of work:

Adult Male Football Development Intern (Suggested location - Winklebury Football Complex, Basingstoke)

- Support the delivery of league and club engagements projects (Early Warning System & Play On Website)
- Support the delivery and development of affiliated and recreational male, open aged football
- > Deliver adult male development specific projects

Women & Girls Football Development Intern (Suggested Location - Winklebury Football Complex, Basingstoke)

- Support the development of the Clubs & League pathway for female football
- Support the development of a more diverse workforce through female coaches, referees, and volunteers
- Coordination of participation projects including Weetabix Wildcats and Squad Girls Football
- > Actively support delivery of Women's Recreational Football Sessions
- Delivery of Female Futsal League

Equality & Inclusion Intern (Suggested Location - Winklebury Football Complex, Basingstoke)

- > Assist the delivery of existing Local Reference Groups and the creation of new groups across the county
- Support the collection data for the delivery of the Equality Action Plan
- > Deliver equality and inclusion specific projects

Marketing & Communications Intern (Suggested Location - Stoneham Lane Football Complex, Southampton)

- Support the Hampshire FA and the FA's National Marketing Campaigns
- Support with social media management, website updates and organisation and implementation of Hampshire FA events
- Support with Business Development tasks

Design Intern (Suggested Location - Stoneham Lane Football Complex, Southampton)

- Support Hampshire FA with content creating (graphics, videography, editing)
- Support with brand management and development across the company
- Support the creative development of marketing campaigns
- > Have a good understanding of design trends within the football/sport industry
- Have access to Adobe software (via your university/course) and a laptop
