

Hampshire FA Coaches Community Terms & Conditions of use

This statement outlines the key behaviours and standards expected from those persons who wish to join the Hampshire FA Coaches Community. Upon registering for your community (via Google Form), you will be required to agree to abide by the following;

It is a breach of FA rules/regulations to post comments that are threatening, abusive, indecent, insulting, racist or are discriminatory. This includes sexual comments, harassment and or grooming behaviour, any of which will result in such incidents being reported to the police.

Any breaches of the terms of conditions may result in you being removed from the Hampshire FA Coaches Community Hive Group and subsequently any comments posted by members that breach FA rules will result in disciplinary action being taken against the individual(s).

Please note persons under the age of 16 are not permitted to access The Hampshire FA Coaches Community.

Organising 'Informal' Coaches Catch-Up Events

- 3. Ensure each event has a minimum of 3 attendees (including yourself), any less the event will not be approved
