Such representatives shall not be members of a Standing Committee but may be coopted to a Standing Committee.

The Council may from time to time vary the number of Members on Council as circumstances dictate either by not filling vacancies which occur by resignation, retirement or otherwise, or if an increase is considered necessary by advertisement or by election. An Ad Hoc Committee shall be appointed by Council in accordance with Articles 53 and 55 to interview prospective members and prepare a short list for

Such representatives shall be subject to Articles [48 and 49] and shall be entitled to attend Council and any other Committee to which they may be appointed and be entitled to vote and to such privileges as the Council may from time to time determine. Such representatives shall not be members of a Standing Committee but may be co-opted to a Standing Committee.
