In my coaching journey to date I've worked with players of all ages from U6 to U19 and in all formats of the game 5v5, 7v7, 9v9 and 11v11. I have worked with elite youth players – some of the very best in the country.

Other Experience: I have coached in grass roots, on summer camps abroad, at school sessions, on player development programs and at college level also. I have worked with both boys and girls.

What I'm looking for (Ideally)

- Must be working within the Boys game. Must be a Head Coach / Manager role (Non-Negotiable)
- Complete control of my environment regarding training sessions and player recruitment (Non-negotiable)
- 11 v 11 format: U13 to U21 (Would consider U12 for a season in preparation for the following year).
- Training twice a week for two hours each (ideally one of these sessions at least would be midweek on a 3G pitch)
- The opportunity to record training sessions via a drone (potentially some matches too with permission)
- Ideally a team in the top two divisions in whichever county / regional league you compete in.
- The freedom to bring in my own assistant Of critical importance.
- Some sort of pay would be fantastic.

I can appreciate what is listed above sounds like a lot but what I can absolutely guarantee you is the most professional setup you've ever seen (especially within grass roots). I'm a young coach (31 years old) with a very progressive football philosophy, I'm just looking for the right opportunity that will allow me to implement it to the extent that I want to.
