BSCFC Summer Tournament RULES 2019

U7's/ U8's / U9's / U10's / U11's / U12's

1. Unless specified below the normal Laws of Association Football will apply Each registered player shall only play for one team
2. The age group for your team is for the season just ended i.e. Under 11's will have been registered and played as an Under 11 in season 2018/2019. You will be asked to produce evidence of age for players who look older than their age group
3. The tournament for the U7's and U8's will be non competitive
4. Players cannot be rotated between squads once the tournament has started
5. All Games 12 mins straight. Not to be played each way
6. Ball is allowed overhead height for all age groups
7. The retreat rule will be operational – defending team retreat behind half way line for goal kicks.
8. There will be no drop kicks allowed from Goalkeepers. Goalkeeper must distribute by hands or passing out with ball on ground
9. No Offside, Rolling substitutes allowed with referees permission
10. Games at U7 will be 5 players a side (Max 8 payers per squad)
11. Games at U9 & U10 will be 7 players per side (Max 10 players per squad)
12. Games at U8, U11, U12 will be 6 players per side (Max 10 players per squad)
13. Yellow cards will be punished with player receiving 2 minute in sin bin, with no player replacement during this time, (only one yellow card per game)
14. A player who is sent off for misconduct shall not be permitted to take any further part in the competition. The player may be replaced for subsequent matches but not in the match that they were sent off in
15. Referees shall control all matches and any misconduct shall be reported to the appropriate county FA
16. Referees will be provided, the referees decision is final
17. 3 points for a win or default. 0 for a loss, 1 point for a draw
18. If Points are tied in any league then the result between the two teams will be used to determine the winner. If this still does not determine the winner then the teams with the highest goals scored will progress through. In the event that teams are still tied goal difference will be used
19. Draws in semi finals and finals will go to 6 mins extra time (3 mins each way). Thereafter each a penalty shoot out containing 5 kicks per team will take place. Sudden death penalties are taken by players that are on field when whistle is blown
20. All players must be wearing shin guards/Shin Pads
21. Parents must not enter the field of play under any circumstances
22. No jewellery at all is to be worn
23. Football Boots or trainers can be worn
24. A Goalkeeper is not allowed to kick the ball out of his hands (drop kick)
25. A throw out by the goalkeeper replaces a goal kick
26. If goal kicks, the opposition must retreat to the halfway line
27. All players are allowed inside the 'D' area and goalkeepers are allowed out of the D area

All Managers are not permitted to drink alcohol or smoke at the side of the pitch whilst managing their team
