## Festival Rules

Mini Soccer Rules for Under 7 & 8 age groups 5-a-side

22ND AND 23RD JUNE 2019

1	All Football Association Rules will apply with the following exceptions
2	Maximum of 10 players per squad and maximum 5 players on the field of play at any one time.
3	Under 7 & 8 age groups will play Festival Non Competitive Football with no scores being published.
4	All player's must be registered by the designated time on the Registration Sheet. Failure to register your player/s will mean they will not be allowed to play.
5	Games to be played on a League Round Robin Basis. Length of games to be determined once intake of entrants is complete. Games will be played between 5 and 10 minutes each way. No team shall play above the allotted time allowed.
6	Qualified Referees will be used for all matches.
7	The referee's decision is final
8	The first named team must supply the match ball
9	In the event of a colour clash the second named team must change.
10	The size of football is as follows:- Under 7 to Under 9 - Size 3                      Under 10 - Size 4
11	Mementos will be awarded to all players in these age groups at the end of of their games
12	<b><u>RESPECT</u></b> - Any person/s or team found to behaving in an unacceptable manner will be told to leave and the Team/Club they are associated with will be reported via the correct procedure to The Hertfordshire Football Association for their consideration of action.
13	<b>NO DOGS</b> will be allowed on the premises. Owners will be told to take them away.
14	<b>NO ALCOHOL</b> will be permitted. Anyone found to be drinking will be told to throw it away sensibly and refusal will mean they shall be told to leave.
15	<b>All teams <u>MUST</u> have a First Aid Kit Available at all their matches.</b> <b>You will be asked to produce this at Registration Time. Failure to produce a First Aid Kit will mean your team cannot play.</b>

2	Maximum of 10 players per squad and maximum 7 players on the field of play at any one time.
3	Under 9 and Under 10 will play competitive football.
4	Games will be played on a League Basis with minimum of 5 minutes each way to a maximum of 10 minutes each way. Times will be determined once the final entrants have been received.
5	Teams going through to the knock out stages will depend on the number of teams taking part and the number in each division. In the event of teams being level on points then it will be decided by goal difference, then by goals scored, then by result of game between the teams involved. If still no resolution then it will be a penalty shoot out between the teams.
6	In the knock out stages if scores are level at the end of normal time then the teams will go straight into a penalty shoot out. Five player's from each team will take penalties then if still level a sudden death penalty shoot out will take place. Only players who were on the field of play at the final whistle will be allowed to take the penalties.
7	Leagues and knockout stages will be determined on the number teams participating in each age group.
8	Trophies will be awarded to all finalists in each age group.
9	All player's must be registered by the designated time on the Registration Sheet. Failure to register your player/s will mean they will not be allowed to play.
10	Any team found playing an illegal player will have the games that player has participated in awarded to their opposition.

3	Games will be played on a League Basis with minimum of 5 minutes each way to a maximum of 10 minutes each way. Times will be determined once the final entrants have been received.
