

Bushey Rangers 5 a side Competition Rules

Full Competition rules are as follows:

The Competition shall be designated as Under 7 & 8 as of the playing season finished to the 31st August 2019. Tournament rules are covered by normal FA Mini-Soccer rules, with the following exceptions and clarifications:

Each team can register a maximum of 8 players on the day of the competition. Each registered player shall only play for one team. (ID must be available if requested)
All matches to be played as per normal laws of the game **EXCEPT** There will be no offside.
Duration of matches will be 8 minutes one way.

Goal kicks, the goal keeper must roll the ball out under arm from anywhere in the goal area, and after collecting the ball during play.

Throw-ins, are normal 2 handed over head. Overhead height is allowed.

Three substitutes as roll on roll off may be used in any match from those named on the registration form.

In the Under 7 & 8 age group all players must be behind the half way line (Respect Line) when the ball goes out of play for a Goal kick.

Any player sent off during a game or receiving two yellow cards on the day will not be allowed to take any further part in the tournament, Any caution, sending off or misconduct will be reported to the relevant County FA

All age groups are competitive and will be run on a league basis with the top team from each group going into a semi-final / final. Medals will be awarded to all players for 1st & 2nd and a Trophy to the winning team.

League positions will be decided by points. 3 points for a win, 1 point for a draw. In the event of a tie, goal difference determines position. If these are equal, goal scored determines position,

If still equal a penalty shootout determines position, best of 5 then sudden death. 5 players from each side who are on the field of play at the end of playing time shall take a penalty for his team alternating with their opponents. If at the end of this series the score remains equal, sudden death will come into operation with the next player. Should a team have a player(s) sent off by the Referee the opposing team must reduce the number of players to equalise the participants in each time prior to the kicks being taken.

During the Final's if level at full time then 3 minutes of extra time to be played. If still equal a penalty shootout determines position, best of 5 then sudden death as per the above format.

Bushey Rangers 6 a side Competition Rules

Full Competition rules are as follows:

The Competition shall be designated as Under 9, Under 10, Under 11, Under 12, Under 13 and Under 14 as of the playing season finished to the 31st August 2019. Tournament rules are covered by normal FA Mini-Soccer rules, with the following exceptions and clarifications:

Each team can register a maximum of 9 players on the day of the competition. Each registered player shall only play for one team. (ID must be available if requested)
All matches to be played as per normal laws of the game **EXCEPT** There will be no offside.
Duration of matches will be 10 minutes one way.

Goal kicks, the goal keeper must roll the ball out under arm from anywhere in the goal area, and after collecting the ball during play.

Throw-ins, are normal 2 handed over head. Overhead height is allowed.

Two substitutes as roll on roll off may be used in any match from those named on the registration form.

In the Under 9 & 10 age group all players must be behind the half way line (Respect Line) when the ball goes out of play for a Goal kick.

Any player sent off during a game or receiving two yellow cards on the day will not be allowed to take any further part in the tournament, Any caution, sending off or misconduct will be reported to the relevant County FA

All age groups are competitive and will be run on a league basis with the top team from each group going into a semi-final / final. Medals will be awarded to all players for 1st & 2nd and a Trophy to the winning team.

League positions decided by points. 3 points for a win, 1 point for a draw. In the event of a tie, goal difference determines position. If these are equal, goal scored determines position, If still equal a penalty shootout determines position, best of 5 then sudden death.

If at the end of this series the score remains equal, sudden death will come into operation with the 6th player. Should a team have a player(s) sent off by the Referee the opposing team must reduce the number of players to equalise the participants in each time prior to the kicks being taken.

During the Semi-Final / Final if level at full time then 3 minutes of extra time to be played. If still equal a penalty shootout determines position, best of 5 then sudden death as above format.
