2020 Tournament Rules & Regulations 13th and 14th June 2020

Tournament rules are covered by normal FA Mini-Soccer rules, with the following exceptions and clarifications:

All players must be eligible to play in the appropriate age group for the 2019/20 season. You <u>must</u> have ID for all players and if requested it must be shown. Players must be of the correct age before the 31st August this year to play.

No player registered with a Premier League or English Football League Academy under the Elite Player Performance Plan contained within Youth Development Rules shall be permitted to play in the tournament.

No EJA teams shall be permitted to play in the tournament.

Mini-Soccer

No player registered with a Premier League or English Football League Academy under the Elite Player Performance Plan contained within Youth Development Rules shall be permitted to play in the tournament.

Substitutes

Under 6's, U7's & U8's
Under 9's, & U10's
Under 11's, & U12's

5 v 5 with 3 substitutes.
7 v 7 with 5 substitutes.
9 v 9 with 5 substitutes.

Clash of colours

In the event of a clash of colours, the first named team to change their colours. All teams to provide a different set of shirt colour if required.

Responsibilities of the Home Team

The first named team shall provide size 3 balls for the under, 6's, 7's, 8's, 9's and size 4 balls for the under 10's, 11's and U12s.

The winning team shall return the score ASAP to the registration desk. If no winning team, the home team shall return the score.

 $\underline{\textbf{U6/U7}}$ only will be a Fair Play Festival in groups, with a medal for every player – there is $\underline{\textbf{NO}}$ knockout competition in $\underline{\textbf{U6/U7}}$ age group.

Group Stages and Qualification U8 and above

The points for the league stages will be:

3 points for a win

1 point for a draw

0 points for a defeat

Group qualifiers will be decided in order by:

- 1 Highest number of points awarded
- 2 Greatest Goal Difference
- 3 The result between the two teams in the group stages
- 4 Greatest number of goals scored

5 - Sudden death penalty shoot out

Knockout Stages

In the knockout stages (semi-final & final), if the two teams finish level, extra time will be played. 4 minutes straight. If the scores are still level, a penalty shoot-out will occur, starting with a maximum 5 penalties to be taken, only the players that are on the field of play at the end of the game may take penalties. If after 5 penalties there is no outcome, there will be a sudden death penalty shootout with the remaining players on the pitch. If the scores are still level, then you start again from the beginning with sudden death still taking place. NO substitute players will take any penalties.

Misconduct

This tournament Registered Referees to control all matches and uses the yellow and red card system where a player cautioned is recorded to the Senior Referee and sent to the County FA.

Red Card - A player who is sent off for misconduct shall NOT be permitted to take any further part in the tournament. Two yellow cards - in any one match equals a red card and results in a player NOT being permitted to take any further part in the tournament.

Two yellow cards - in the tournament results in a player NOT being permitted to take part in any further matches in the tournament.

5-a-side; 7-a-side Specific Rules

The following mini soccer rules will apply to 5 & 7-a-side age groups:

- All free kicks are direct
- No offsides
- Goalkeepers may NOT pick-up from a pass back
- No step restrictions for goalkeepers
- All age groups the goalkeeper can always kick the ball from his hands except for goal kicks, when these must be taken from the floor.
- · Rolling substitutions are allowed at any time with the permission of the referee
- The referee's decision is Final
- All other FA mini soccer rules will apply

9-a-side Specific Rules

The following rules will apply to all 9-a-side age groups:

- All teams to provide a suitable assistant referee, the Referee will provide flags.
- Goalkeepers may NOT pick-up from a pass back
- Goal kicks from the floor can be taken anywhere inside the penalty area.
- · Rolling substitutions are allowed at any time with the permission of the referee
- · The referee's decision is Final
- All other FA 9-a-side rules will apply

Duration of Play

Under 6's: The matches are 8 minutes straight

(All games are non-competitive, no tables shall be kept, and every child will receive a memento for taking part).

Under 7's: The matches are 10 minutes straight.

(All games are non-competitive, no tables shall be kept, and every child will receive a memento for taking part).

<u>Under 8's</u>: The matches are 10 minutes straight.

Under 9's: The matches are 10 minutes straight.

<u>Under 10's:</u> The matches are 10 minutes straight.

Under 11's: The matches will be 10 minutes straight.

Under 12's: The matches will be 10 minutes straight.

Youth - U13 upwards

Tournament rules are covered by normal FA rules, with the following exceptions and clarifications: All players must be eligible to play in the appropriate age group for the 2019/20 season. You <u>must</u> have ID for all players and if requested it must be shown. Players must be of the correct age before the 31st August this year to play.

No player registered with a Premier League or English Football League Academy under the Elite Player Performance Plan contained within Youth Development Rules shall be permitted to play in the tournament.

No EJA teams shall be permitted to play in the tournament.

Each Team may have a maximum 16 (sixteen) players in their squad. Substitutes will be roll on, roll off as permitted by the Referee.

All matches will be competitive with semi-finals and finals for the top two teams in each group. There will be medals for the runners up & winners.

Match duration will be 12 minutes in all ages U13 upwards with U16 20 minutes but will be played straight, i.e., no half time interval or turn-around.

Match balls: The first named team on the fixture shall provide size 4 balls for the U13 and U14 and Size 5 Balls for U15 and U16.

In the event of a colour clash the first named team shall change shirt colour.

The first named team has choice of ends and the second named team has kick off.

Each team should provide a club's linesman, familiar with the off-side rule.

Group Stages and Qualification U13 and above

The points for the league stages will be:

3 points for a win

1 point for a draw

0 points for a defeat

Group qualifiers will be decided in order by:

- 1 Highest number of points awarded
- 2 Greatest Goal Difference
- 3 The result between the two teams in the group stages
- 4 Greatest number of goals scored
- 5 Sudden death penalty shoot out

Knockout Stages

In the knockout stages (semi-final & final), if the two teams finish level, extra time will be played. 4 minutes straight. If the scores are still level, a penalty shoot-out will occur, starting with a maximum 5 penalties to be taken, only the players that are on the field of play at the end of the game may take penalties. Duration of Play

Under 13's: The matches are 12 minutes straight.

Under 14's: The matches are 12 minutes straight.

Under 15's: The matches are 12 minutes straight.

<u>Under 16's:</u> The matches are 20 minutes straight.

Misconduct

This tournament Registered Referees to control all matches and uses the yellow and red card system where a player cautioned is recorded to the Senior Referee and sent to the County FA.

Red Card - A player who is sent off for misconduct shall NOT be permitted to take any further part in the tournament. Two yellow cards - in any one match equals a red card and results in a player NOT being permitted to take any further part in the tournament.

Two yellow cards - in the tournament results in a player NOT being permitted to take part in any further matches in the tournament.

Referees

Qualified Referees appointed by Panshanger FC will officiate and their decisions will be FINAL in all matters relating to the laws of the game and rules of this tournament. No disagreements with the referees will be tolerated. Any matters arising that are not covered by these rules will be dealt with by the tournament manager. In the event of any dispute the decision of the organising committee will be final.

Miscellaneous

All players must wear shin pads, with all jewellery being removed before the start of play.

All teams must have their own First Aid Kit.

All managers are responsible for ensuring that no single player exceeds the FA guidelines for 'Total playing time in one day.

Panshanger Football Club will <u>NOT</u> be deemed responsible and can accept <u>NO</u> liability whatsoever for any accident, injury or loss that may occur, however caused, throughout the duration of the tournament.

<u>Litter:</u> All teams entering will be provided with a litter bin bag, please ensure all your team/parents/players litter is collected in this bag and put into a bin which will be placed around the field, - please let <u>ALL</u> your parents know of this in advance of the day.

<u>Car Park:</u> Programs will be sold for £2.00 at the entrance of the car park, please ask <u>ALL</u> parents to have their monies ready to enable a quick transaction upon entry.

Programs help raise valuable money for the club and enable Panshanger FC to invest in the players themselves and the local community.
