Huntingdonshire FA Pitch Improvement Programme

Huntingdonshire FA has been working in partnership with The FA Facilities & Investment team and the Institute of Groundmanship (IOG) to develop a grass pitch maintenance service.

This can be utilised by grassroots football clubs, Parish Councils, Local Authorities and Schools, with the simple aim of improving the quality of grass pitches.

The need for the Pitch Improvement Programme (PIP) is more relevant now than ever, given the current economic times and the pressures facing grassroots football. The key principles behind the service are to provide groundstaff with advice and practical solutions on a number of areas.
