

JERSEY FOOTBALL COMBINATION & JERSEY FOOTBALL ASSOCIATION PLAYER COMBINED REGISTRATION SCHEME GUIDANCE NOTES FOR PLAYERS



Introduction

All players wishing to play open-aged football for clubs affiliated to the JFC, JFA or for JFA and JFC representative teams in age groups Under 11 and above must, every season, firstly register with the Jersey Football Combination (JFC) Jersey Football Association (JFA) Player Registration Schemes and must pay an Annual Registration Fee (ARF) as set by the JFA.

The Registration Scheme provides players with the required level of insurance cover to meet the requirements of the FA Standard Code of Rules that include a provision whereby it is mandatory for all players registered to openaged Clubs to be members of a players' personal accident scheme.

What benefits do I receive?

Registration provides registered players with Player-to-Player Liability insurance and Personal Accident insurance, the terms of which can be found on the JFA website or by request by emailing info@JerseyFA.com. Players may also choose to purchase additional Personal Accident insurance.

Coverage under this scheme will be provided automatically when a player's registration is cleared by the JFA.

How much will it cost?

Adults (Aged 18 to 35 years of age) £35

Adults (Over 35 years of age) £25

Juniors (Under 11 - Under 18 age groups) £35

Juniors (Under 11 - Under 18 age groups) 2nd Child £25

Juniors (Under 11 - Under 18 age groups) 3rd Child £0

If you are over 18 and a student in full time education or attending University you will pay £15.00 per season.

When must it be paid?

Registration fees can be made from April 1st for the following season and must be paid before a player can play for their club and/or the JFA/JFC Representative teams. Payments are annual and must be paid for every season in which the player wishes to play.

How & where do I pay?

Our preferred method of payment is by credit/debit card via the on-line payment portal on the JFA website, www.jerseyfa.com.







Payments by cheque or cash will also be accepted. Cheques should be made payable to Jersey FA and must be accompanied by a competed Player Registration Form. These can be sent or delivered to The JFA office at Springfield Stadium, Janvrin Road, St Helier JE2 4LF.

Cash payments must also be accompanied by a competed Player Registration Form and can only be made in person at the Jersey FA office.

Players who have paid the registration fee will receive confirmation of payment.



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Penalties for Non-Payment.

Where a player who has not paid the ARF plays football for clubs affiliated to the JFC, JFA or for JFA and JFC representative teams, that club may be fined by the JFA and the result of the match may be awarded to the opposing team. The player may be suspended by the JFA from playing football for clubs affiliated to the JFA or for JFA or JFC representative teams. Such suspension will last until such time as the ARF is paid and clearance to play is authorised by the JFA or, until the end of the football season within which the payment would have applied.

How will a Club know which players have paid?

The JFA will provide each club by e-mail on a regular basis their registered players list, i.e. those who have paid their registration fee and been cleared to play by the JFA. Clubs can also 'self serve' and check their list of registered players through an Internet portal.

What happens when players transfer during season?

Player transfers during the season will have no effect on the Registration scheme

Refund Policy.

The JFA doesn't offer refunds for registration fees, although a full refund will be offered for any payment taken in error.

Sharing of Personal Details.

The JFC and JFA does not share your personal details with any third party other than your football club and the insurers.
