# A Brief History of Ribbleton FC



Ribbleton Football Club began life as Denville Devils in 2000 with seven players that resided on Denville Road in Ribbleton and played on the 5 a side pitches adjacent to Preston North End. This soon expanded to 14 players, representing Ribbleton in two competitive teams on a weekly basis.

During the summer of 2001, five parents formed a committee and the club became Ribbleton Juniors FC. They became affiliated to the Lancashire FA and joined the Mid Lancs Colts Junior Football League, entering an Under 9's team.

Since that first year they have developed teams every year providing football for players from Ribbleton, Callon, Brookfield and beyond from six years of age through to seniors.

They now have almost 400 players representing 29 teams from Under six to Seniors in the Mid Lancs Colts, Central Lancs, Lancashire Sunday League and Lancashire FA leagues. They also have five girls teams representing the club in the Poulton & District and North Valley & Burnley Unity Youth Leagues.
