- Holmes Park This is the Headquarters for Leicestershire & Rutland CFA. Based in Whetstone, it is the place where all County Cup finals are played and as well as many League Cup Finals. Leicester City FC Under 23's play their Home games here throughout the season. Holmes Park has two Large function rooms and 3 smaller meetings rooms as well as a newly resurfaced 3G pitch, all of which can be hired.
- DBS (also known as a CRC) minimum standards It is law that anyone over the age of 16 is required to have a valid DBS if regularly working with children under the age of 18. The FA require a DBS to be complete through their official channels (will not accept one from other sources).
