

County Team Manager and Coaches

Roles and Responsibilities

A County Team Manager or Coach shall: -

1. Required Qualifications

Hold the following qualifications;

- a. A current FA DBS
- b. An FA Coaching Qualification

2. Conduct

- a. Up hold and maintain the ESFA Code of Conduct for Players, Staff and Parents
- b. Maintain the County's required high standards in term of dress and behaviour, both on and off the field of play

3. Selection

- a. Hold trials and liaise with the County Secretary
- b. The selection of the Association's Representative Side should be selected by the elected Management Team
- c. The Association's Representative Team shall be selected on merit/ability.
- d. All affiliated associations and schools within Lincolnshire shall be invited to nominate players.

4. Match Arrangements

a. Fixtures are arranged in conjunction with the County Secretary

When a squad has been selected it will be placed on the County website and on its twitter account.

- b. The Team Manager will be expected to contact the parents of the squad by text/email to obtain confirmation of availability for the match. Also inform the parents in the event of a postponement
- All playing kit, tracksuits, footballs and first aid will be provided by the County.

5. Annual Report

Each Team Manager will be required to submit an Annual Report to the Secretary on the relevant age group team to include a report of the matches and results played and a list of all players who have represented the County.
