County Cup Postponement Procedure



Is the match in doubt?

Lack of players: If you have a lack of players for a match, you should firstly contact the opposition team, match official and Norfolk County FA as soon as possible and make them aware of the situation. Not fulfilling the fixture therefore means you will forfeit the tie.

Weather: In the event of a match being postponed or abandoned because of weather conditions, the home club must to notify Norfolk County FA of the postponement/abandonment as soon as possible and by no later than 1 hour after the scheduled completion time of the fixture.

A Registered Match Official will conduct a pitch inspection if there is any doubt on the pitch due adverse weather conditions. This applies to all Norfolk Senior Cup matches (prior to Semi Final) and all matches from the 4th Round onwards in all other competitions.

Rearranged Fixtures

Norfolk Senior Cup:

- Played in the midweek following the Friday/Saturday fixture or seven days after the original date.
- If a midweek fixture is postponed or abandoned the match shall be played in the following midweek, unless both clubs agree to play on the Saturday following the original midweek date.

All other competitions:

- Played seven days after the original date
- Or the midweek following if consent is obtained from Norfolk County FA

Abandoned games will be considered on a case by case basis by delegated committee who will determine the outcome of the tie.

Changing a fixture

In all competitions except for the Norfolk Senior Cup:

- Ties prior to the Quarter Finals may be played on no later than the weekend following the date of the Round.
- Confirmation from both clubs and Norfolk County FA must be obtained no later than 10 days prior to the original match date.

In the John Savage, Stuart Dracup and Under 12's Cups:

- Any tie prior to the Quarter Finals can kick off at an alternative time.
- Such agreement shall be confirmed with both clubs and Norfolk County FA no later than 3 days before the date of the fixture.
