

Club Policies & Procedures

- Embed the Clubs Codes of Conduct throughout the Club
- Ensure all Club members understand the terms and sign the Club Codes of Conduct
- Revisit these Codes of Conduct should a player/s, team officials, spectators of Club officials do not adhere to the conduct
- Embed the FA Respect Campaign throughout the Club
- Ensuring that the Club display Respect in the Club house, changing rooms and pitch side where possible

In-house Club Discipline

- Conduct a Club meeting to discuss behaviour and consequences the Club face
- One-to-One's with reoccurring offenders to address their behaviour and inform them of the consequences the Club faces due to their actions
- Implementing a Club suspension policy – for all players, managers, club officials to understand and adhere too.
- Implementing a Club fine procedure – any club member that is cautioned for dissent or misconduct offences are fined additional to that of the caution, all club members review, adopt and sign to confirm that have understood the procedure

Other

- Respect & Discipline made as a discussion point at each Committee Meeting
- The Club can request a Norfolk FA 'Through the Eyes of the Referee' workshop – a qualified referee (relevant level) to present to Club members expectations and match day experiences
