'LINO' WORKSHOP

This workshop is aimed to upskill club volunteers who assist the referees on a match day by picking up the flag! With this workshop, we will look to build on confidence and knowledge of the volunteer whilst covering the following topics;

- Correct flag techniques
- The best viewing positioning required to give accurate signals
- Laws of the Game that an assistant referee would need to know

The overall outcome of the workshop is to ensure individuals gain a better understanding of the assistant referee role.

INTRODUCTION TO COACHING WORKSHOP

This workshop is for the non-qualified coach, for example parents, assistants and volunteers who want to get a taster of what a FA Level 1 course entails. It's also for those individuals waiting to attend their FA Level 1 course; to ensure that in the meantime, coaches actively coaching without a qualification are demonstrating good practice whilst they wait to attend the FA Level 1 course.

It will prepare coaches with the 'need to knows'; how to create a safe environment for player development, how to deliver appropriate sessions, an update on the FA coach pathway and an introduction as to what they can expect from the FA Level 1.

YOUTH – ADULT: SETTING THE ENVIRONMENT

A workshop to provide good practice for adult Clubs to ensure the youth to adult transition is as smooth and engaging as possible. This will be delivered by experienced and knowledgable FA Tutors.

TRANSITION SUPPORT WORKSHOPS: 5V5 TO 7V7, 7V7 TO 9V9 & 9V9 TO 11V11

This workshop is for managers and coaches to gain useful coaching tips to help support individual players and the team transition from different formats of football. It's a great opportunity to network with other team officials in the same position as well as the very experienced and knowledgable FA Tutors.

NORFOLK FA TRANSITION FESTIVALS

Our Transition Festivals offer a learning experience for all, players will participate in fixtures and a coaching session delivered by FA Coaches, managers / coaches will be supported by a FA Coach Mentor throughout the festival and spectators will be invited to workshops to improve the environment in which the football will be played in.

FOOTBALL FUTURES SPECIFIC TRAINING

A bespoke programme will be delivered for budding young coaches and referees (12 – 24 years old). Each training programme will cover numerous topics to develop their knowledge and skills to take back into their club; it will introduce them to County FA and FA Staff and will also highlight the importance of self-review.
