The FDC Arena pitch and surroundings are nearing completion.

The latest developments have seen all the carpet being put down, sand and rubber crumb being spread onto the pitch and the electrical wiring up of the floodlights has been completed. The flooring has also been put down in the hospitality unit, allowing the work to begin on fitting it with furniture and units.
