STEP 4 UPDATE ON 'NON- ELITE' FOOTBALL

Earlier this month, The FA provided an update on 'non-elite' football regarding Step 4 of the Government's roadmap.

This updated guidance which covers Steps 3-6 of the National League System (NLS), Tiers 3-6 of the Women's Football Pyramid and grassroots football (including Regional NLS Feeder Leagues), came into effect on Monday 19 July.

The new guidance, which is specifically focused on training sessions where most of the heading occurs, has been designed to meet the requirements of each level of English football. The guidance will be applicable to clubs in the Premier League, EFL, Barclays Women's Super League, FA Women's Championship, the National League System, the Women's Football Pyramid Tiers 3 and below, all grassroots football, and across the England national teams.


