The Lionesses have inspired us all and that includes the next generation of female footballers as well as adults, thanks to their incredible success in the Women's EUROs 2022. They beat Germany 2-1 in the final at Wembley, having gone unbeaten throughout the whole tournament.





But substitute Chloe Kelly provided the decisive goal on 110 minutes, poking home from close-range before wheeling away in celebration in front of 87,192 fans. Click here to read more.

#### PITCH OFFERS AT THE FDC

The FDC in Norwich is running a special offer on small-sided pitch hire bookings in the late night slot of 9-10pm.

The FDC currently has good availability across its small-sided pitches for the last booking of each weeknight evening, and these slots are currently available with a 20% reduction on top of the standard off-peak price when a block booking is made.



With an already reduced off-peak rate that puts 7-a-side pitches at £30 per hour and 5-a-side pitches at just £20 per hour, this latest offer means that bookers can secure a pitch for as little as only £16 per week. To find out more, please click here.




