

The local grassroots football club fell victim to a malicious online phishing scam over the summer which resulted in them losing over two thirds of their capital.


They are now trying to recoup the funds as well as raise awareness of the importance of internet safety via their 'Walk to Wembley' event.

On January 21 2018, Freethorpe players, coaches, managers, officials and friends and family will take to the club's pitches to walk a combined 1000 laps of the playing field, totalling 266 miles – the distance from Freethorpe to Wembley and back.

Last season's FA Grassroots Survey highlighted that football pitch quality is affecting participation.




In anticipation of both this and the current economic climate affecting local authority pitch maintenance, The FA Facilities & Investment Team has developed a Grass Pitch Maintenance service that can be utilised by grassroots football clubs with the simple aim of improving the quality of grass pitches.

The key principle behind the service is to provide football clubs/site providers with advice/practical solutions on a number of areas and discounts on machinery and materials to support, ultimately improving the club's playing surface.
