CHARTER STANDARD

The FA Charter Standard Programme is The FA's accreditation scheme open to all grassroots clubs and leagues. It aims to raise standard in the grassroots game, supporting the development of clubs and leagues, recognising and rewarding commitment, quality and achievement.

Charter Standard Clubs are required to renew their status each season via the Annual Health Check. The Health Check process should be regarded as a positive tool to maintain and keep on top of records, volunteers and constitution. If clubs are not awarded their Annual Health Check by the deadline, their Charter Standard status will lapse.

FOOTBALL WORKFORCE EDUCATION PROGRAMME

We provide a full programme of courses for coaches, teachers, young leaders, referees, first aiders and volunteers. These include FA Level 1 and 2 in Coaching Football courses, Goalkeeping Coaching Level 1, FA Level 1 Introduction to First Aid in Football, FA Level 2 Emergency First Aid in Football, Safeguarding Children in Football and Welfare Officers' workshops and FA Referee courses. All of these are delivered by FA-qualified staff at suitable venues across Norfolk.

Please note that all course places **must** be booked online by the individual attending, however if the club wishes to pay for course places this can be done by BACs, card, cheque or cash. Once payment is received a code will be issued so that an online booking can be made 'FOC'.
