To be eligible to apply to be part of the FA RYN you must first fill one of the following criteria in Part A:-

Part A – one of these must describe you

- I am an active member of a County FA (CFA) Youth Council or equivalent Youth Leadership programme hosted by a CFA.
- I am a member of a FANYC 'Partner' organisations Youth Leadership/Committee/Programme. Current partners include: AoC Sport through AoC Sport Women's Football Development Officer (Apprentices) Programme and Activators, BUCS through FA University Women's Leadership Programme, Committee members and Activators, Football Beyond Borders, Youth Sport Trust, Brent Blueprint Collective, Football v Homophobia.
- Whilst I am not part of a CFA YC or 'Partner' organisation I am actively involved on a voluntary basis supporting young people to develop themselves and participate in football.

If you meet one of the criteria above now check that you meet the other criteria in Part B below:-

Part B - these must all describe you

- I will be between 16 24 years old as of the 1st August and live in England.
- I'm excited by the FANYCs Vision and having the opportunity to help bring this to life.
- I am committed and interested in engaging with personal development opportunities for myself and others.
- I want to represent the voice of children and young people in football.
- I am willing and excited to support the delivery of FA NYC projects.
- I want to represent CFA YC/Youth Leadership Programmes and similar.
- I will utilise the opportunity to be part of the FA RYN to support the development of CFA YC/Youth Leadership Programmes and similar.
- I am committed to ensuring that all Young People have equal opportunity to be part of the football community, to influence change, and develop a lasting legacy in football.

- Independent Members there will be two places per region available
