Title: Coach Menteeship – Women's Football

Organisation: UoN WF&F / NTUWFC Grade: Voluntary

Supervisor: Head Coach & Coach Dev. Hours: 5-10 hours per week – during BUCS

Responsibilities:

- Supporting lead coaches to ensure training session's link to the club philosophy and playing strategies.
- Planning and delivering warm-ups and technical sessions. Building up experience to lead tactical sessions.
- Using video to support technical and tactical feedback to players.
- Working with individuals and units to improve performance.
- Preparing players on match day.
- Helping to manage equipment and resources effectively.
- Adhere to University policies and procedures for health & safety and welfare reporting any incidents formally.
