Participation Committee

Role

The Participation Committee is appointed by the Board of Directors to assist the Board of Directors in discharging its Football Participation responsibilities and to maintain the highest possible standards of Participation in the game

Main Responsibilities

To sustain and increase participation within the County

Main Tasks

- Clubs
- Leagues
- Players
- Facilities
- Flexible Formats
- Charter Standard

Membership of the Participation Committee

- The Committee shall be Chaired by a member of Council, and at least one member of the Board of Directors shall be a member together with the relevant members of staff. The quorum necessary for the transaction of business is five members.
- All members of the Committee will have experience and skills directly relevant to the work of the Committee.
- The Board of Directors are responsible for appointing members of the Committee.
- The Chairperson, Vice Chairperson and President will be entitled to attend as ex officio members.
- The core qualities and experience required for membership of the Committee will be determined by the Board of Directors and may be modified in particular cases if the Board of Directors considers that appropriate.

Meetings

- The Committee will meet at least once a year at an appropriate time but the Working Groups will meet on as many occasions as required to carry out the business of the Committee.
- Decisions will normally be taken on the basis of consensus, and otherwise on the basis of a simple majority, of members present and voting at a duly convened meeting. The Chairperson may cast a second or casting vote only if there is a tied vote.
