REFEREE

To help young referees in grassroots football we will be providing a free 'purple shirt' to qualified match officials under the age of 18. This has been introduced to improve the match day environment for match officials, as well as highlight to players, spectators and coaches that the referee is under the age of 18 and this should be taken into consideration on a match day.



SMALL SIDED SERIES

From November 2019

Somerset FA will be running a series of adult small sided events for male and female players aged 16+, veterans male & female (35+) and super veterans (50+ Male) throughout season 2019/20, culminating in a "Road to Euro 2020" event in May 2020. Get those boots back on and get involved!



Somerset FA is seeking to appoint local independent members for the County Association Local Football Anti-Discrimination Panel. (LFADP) and Disciplinary Commissions. We are looking for a diverse group of committed individuals across the Country with a variety of backgrounds to be reflective of the local community and grassroots football. Applicants need to be independent from The FA and County FA structures and ideally will have relevant experience of equality and/or discipline fundamentals (although training is provided for the right candidate) to sit and adjudicate on matters related to discipline and/or discrimination.



CLUB FUTSAL FESTIVALS

Boys & Girls – Under 10 & Under 12

Fast, Furious and Fun! Season 2019/20 will see Somerset FA run Futsal Festivals for grassroots clubs for the first time! These festivals are part of The FA's National Futsal Festival where teams could progress to be in a national competition.



DISABILITY FOOTBALL PLEDGE

Disability Football is one of the beautiful games greatest secrets and we need your support to promote the wide variety of opportunities across the region. Footballs biggest secret? Not anymore! This is why we are asking all grassroots clubs to pledge their support to promoting disability football within the County through a disability football pledge with club incentives on offer.

SOMERSET FA MINI MONEY

Available from Jan 2020

Somerset FA are pleased to launch a 'Mini Money' fund aimed at generating Mini Soccer Teams across the County. This £100 kick start fund is the first of its kind for Somerset, and we invite any existing club wishing to generate a team in an age group (Under 7 to Under 10) that they do not already cater for, or for entirely new clubs wishing to form.

SOMERSET FA TEAM GENERATION FUND

Available from Jan 2020

To aid the creation of youth (under 11 upwards) and adult male football teams in the county, Somerset FA are launching a Team Growth Fund allowing clubs to generate new male teams from 11 years of age upwards with a £150 kick start fund. Somerset FA affiliated clubs not eligible for Grow the Game or Mini Money funding are also invited to apply to this fund

FOOTBALL FOUNDATION GROW THE GAME GRANT

Female & Disability

Available for Feb 2020

The Foundation's Grow the Game Scheme provides grants of up to £1,500 for the creation of new football teams (female and disability) and coaching qualifications, with money provided by The FA. The scheme is delivered by the Foundation and is active later this season.

SOMERSET FA DISABILITY 'TURN UP & PLAY FUNDING'

Available from September 2019

To support the development of disability provision, Somerset FA are launching a £150 kick start fund to support recreational informal disability provision. This fund is for adult and youth provision (Male & Female) and will cover numerous impairments.

CLUB MAINTENANCE SCHEME

Does your changing room need a lick of paint? Or perhaps you need a little help with funds to improve your grass pitch? Somerset FA is inviting clubs from around the County to submit an application which could give them the opportunity to apply for materials or equipment (up to £500) to help with on going club maintenance.

£750

FOOTBALL FOUNDATION STAY IN THE GAME

Available from Feb 2020

Formerly known as Retain the Game, this scheme is aimed at supporting the retention of adult male teams. The scheme provides grants of £750 to clubs with existing male teams to support the essential costs of pitch hire, training venues, and affiliation fees.
