## **WHO CAN APPLY**

Stay in the Game will offer support to clubs to help with the retention of adult male football. We therefore invite applications from:

The following age groups and club categories are eligible for support;

Clubs that operate with two or more male teams (u/18, u/19, u/21, u/23, Open Age and Vets) and

- Hold the FA's Charter Standard Award (Adult, Youth, Development or Community)
- Adult Clubs that commit to become FA Charter Standard within season 2019/20
