CLUB RULES -DEMOCRACY OVER DICTATORSHIP

Club Rules are important. The FA provide template club rules, however clubs, and their members have the autonomy to create and adopt club rules as they see fit. It is important that club members understand the club rules and that the content preserves the right of the membership to check and challenge the decisions made by the Management Committee. The rules should include details of the clubs complaints policy and appeals procedure and a provision for members to call an EGM.
