1.3.

Player nationality

Each player must be eligible to represent England internationally and in possession of a valid passport containing a photograph and giving full particulars of their date of birth (day, month, year). Each player must have residency within the UK. The FA reserves the right to remove anyone who does not meet the criteria at any stage of the process.

If you qualify for the live event you must enter into a pre-agreement with The FA which will become active if you secure a place as an eLion.

1.5

Participation stipulations

The qualifying tournament will be played on an external platform provided by FIFA. Before participating you will be required to sign up to the terms and conditions of the platform.

By entering the tournament, you are agreeing that if you secure a qualification place you will take part in any required pre-final promotion and participate in the finals live online broadcast on 11-12 February 2021.

Usernames/Team names
