WRITTEN REASONS AND DECISION OF THE INDEPENDENT REGULATORY COMMISSION FOLLOWING THE HEARING

ON 25 NOVEMBER 2016

Background

- 1. These are the written reasons for a decision made by an Independent Regulatory Commission which sat by WebEx on 25 November 2016.
- 2. The Regulatory Commission members were Mr G Farrelly, Chairman, Mr M Robinson and Mr M Kearns.
- 3. Mr P McCormack of the FA Judicial Services Department acted as Secretary to the Regulatory Commission.
- 4. By letter dated 9 November 2016, The Football Association ("The FA") charged Mr Simon Glover with Misconduct for a breach of FA Rule E3 in respect of the fixture between Heybridge Swifts FC v Bury Town FC.
- 5. It was alleged that in the game in question on 27 September 2016, Mr Glover used abusive and/or insulting and/or threatening language towards the Match Referee following his dismissal.
- 6. The FA designated this as a Non Standard Case due to the fact that the incident occurred outside the jurisdiction of the Match Officials and due to the threatening nature of the reported behaviour.
- 7. In the Extraordinary Incident Report Form the Referee stated "Off showing Simon Glover the red card he started to march off the pitch shouting foul and a suite language at me and threating me. He was shouting I was a fucking cunt and a fucking wanker and that he was going to smash my face in!"
- 8. This was further supported by the Assistant Referee who heard Mr Glover shouting at the Referee "you're a fucking wanker, you're lucky I don't come back there and smash your face in".
- 9. For completeness, the other Assistant Referee was not in a position to hear what was said.
- 10. The Charge was admitted on 19 November 2016.
- 11. Mr Glover did not request a personal hearing and the case was dealt with on the papers only.
- 12. Mr Glover had no previous record of similar misconduct.
- 13. The Regulatory Commission considered all of the evidence presented and ruled there to be a number of critical points. It is accepted that Match Officials at all levels have a difficult role. There is simply no place for the foul and abusive language as used in this case nor the aggressive threatening behaviour.

Conclusion

- 14. The Regulatory Commission came to a unanimous decision, having carefully considered the evidence, and have imposed the following sanction on Mr Glover:
- (i) He is suspended for four (4) matches;
- (ii) Fined the sum of £100; and
- (iii) He is warned as to his future conduct.
- 15. This decision is subject to the relevant Appeal Regulations.
