

1 The Promoter

The Promoter of the Competition is The Football Association Limited ("The FA"), Wembley Stadium, Wembley, London, HA9 0WS.

2 The competition

- 2.1 The title of the competition is FA Girls' Football Week - Join Our Squad.
- 2.2 Girls' Football Week participants will submit squad selfie images via Twitter and Instagram using #JoinOurSquad. The winner will be selected by England Women's player Nikita Parris and Twice the Health (Emily Kier & Hannah Tyldesley) and will be based on the originality of the image and size of the squad.

3 How to enter

- 3.1 The promotion will run from 09.00 on Monday 6 November 2017 until 00.00 Sunday 12 November 2017 (The Term).
- 3.2 Entrants will be required to capture an image of them and fellow participants at an FA Girls' Football Week session during and submit via Twitter and/or Instagram using #JoinOurSquad during The Term to enter.
- 3.3 All competition entries must be received by the Promoter by the Closing Date in the relevant month. All competition entries received after the Closing Date are automatically disqualified.
- 3.4 To enter the competition you will need to use #JoinOurSquad in any image submission.

4 Eligibility

- 4.1 The competition is open to participants and coaches taking part in The FA's Girls' Football Week - Higher Education initiative.
- 4.2 The Promoter reserves all rights to disqualify you if your conduct is contrary to the spirit or intention of the Prize competition.

5 The Prize

- 5.1 The prize (the "Prize") is up to 10x tickets to the 2017/18 SSE Women's FA Cup Final.
- 5.2 You must not transfer or sell the Tickets. The unauthorised sale or disposal of tickets is a criminal offence under section 166 of the Criminal Justice and Public Order Act 1994, as amended by the Violent Crime Reduction Act 2006.
- 5.3 You understand that the Promoter may pass personal information relating to Prize winners to The FA for the purposes of monitoring the distribution and use of the Tickets and, in the event of a suspected breach of any terms and conditions, investigating and taking action against such winners.
- 5.4 If you are the subject of a current Banning Order under the Football Spectators Act 1989 (as amended) you will be refused entry to this

promotion and to all Stadiums. The Promoter will not be liable for any such omission or refusal.

- 5.5 The Prize does not include: (i) travel to and from the Stadium; and (ii) all other incidental costs. Any other costs incurred in addition to those set out above and that are incidental to the fulfilment of the Prize are the responsibility of the winner(s).
- 5.6 There is no cash alternative for the Prize.
- 5.7 The Prize is not negotiable or transferable.
- 5.8 The Promoter cannot guarantee that the Prize will be free from disruption failing and/or error.

6 Winner announcement

- 6.1 The winner will be selected by Nikita Parris and Twice the Health (Emily Kier & Hannah Tyldesley) by Friday 17 November 2017.
- 6.2 The winner will be announced via The FA's social media channels once they have confirmed receiving communication regarding their win from The FA.
- 6.3 The decision of the Promoter is final and no correspondence or discussion will be entered into.
- 6.4 The Promoter will use reasonable endeavours to contact the relevant month's winner personally as soon as practicable using social media, the telephone number or email address if available.

7 Claiming the Prize

- 7.1 The Prize may not be claimed by a third party on your behalf.
- 7.2 If the winner cannot be contacted or is not available, or has not claimed their Prize within 48 hours from the date the Promoter contacts you as set out in 6.3 above, the Promoter reserves the right to offer the Prize to the next eligible entrant selected from the correct entries that were received before the relevant month's Closing Date.
- 7.3 The Promoter does not accept any responsibility if you are not able to take up the Prize.

8 Limitation of liability

- 8.1 Insofar as is permitted by law, the Promoter, its agents or distributors will not in any circumstances be responsible or liable to compensate the winner or accept any liability for any loss, damage, personal injury or death occurring as a result of taking up the Prize except where it is caused by the negligence of the Promoter, its agents or distributors or that of their employees. Your legal rights are not affected.
- 8.2 As the Promoter is procuring the Prize rather than providing the Prize itself, the Promoter shall not be liable for any act or omission of the Prize

providers, and you now agree that you do not hold the Promoter at fault for any fault of the Prize provider.

9 Data protection and publicity

- 9.1 If you are the winner of the competition, you agree that the Promoter may use your name, image and town or county of residence to announce the winner of this competition and for any other reasonable and related promotional purposes.
- 9.2 You further agree to participate in any reasonable publicity required by the Promoter.
- 9.3 By entering the competition you agree that any personal information provided by you with the competition entry may be held and used only by the Promoter or its agents and suppliers to administer the competition, or if you tick any of the boxes below, on the basis set out in our Privacy Policy below.

10 General

- 10.1 If there is any reason to believe that there has been a breach of these terms and conditions, the Promoter may, at its sole discretion, reserve the right to exclude you from participating in the competition.
- 10.2 The Promoter reserves the right to hold void, suspend, cancel, or amend the Prize competition where it becomes necessary to do so.
- 10.3 These terms and conditions shall be governed by English law, and the parties submit to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England and Wales.
