There must not be another game on the pitch prior to an FA Sunday Cup tie. There are no replays in The FA Sunday Cup, if a match is level at the end of 90 minutes, extra time of 15 minutes each way must be played. If the scores are still level at the end of extra time, kicks from the penalty mark shall be taken to decide the winner.

PLAYER QUALIFICATION DATE

The player qualification date is 12 noon on Saturday 19 September 2009, this also includes postponements.

MEMBER IN CHARGE

Each tie will have appointed, by The FA, either a member of The FA Sunday Cup Committee or an official from the Home clubs County FA. On match days the member in charge will make contact with the Match Officials and will report back to The FA on the ground facilities and the conduct of each team and supporters.
