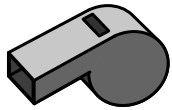
CLUB HISTORY

CLUB HISTORY

Formed in 2018, Clapton Community FC is a fan-owned, fan-run football club, based in East London.

CCFC's Women's First Team was formed before the 19/20 season, after the merging with AFC Stoke Newington's adult side.

They currently play in Greater London Women's Football League, Premier Division.

This season, they have made history.

The Tons were the first ever Tier 7 team to reach the third round proper of the FA Cup, and they were the first ever team to beat a team 4 tiers higher up.

In addition of reaching the final of the Capital Women's Cup, they are also in the semi-final of their League Cup.
