





PITCH IMPROVEMENT PROGRAMME 2019

Clubs/organisations submit EOI to CFA & receive a PIP visit – cost of the visit is £100



County FA/RPA

Following the submittance of EOI form CFA/RPA to prioritise which organisation receive a visit in line with agreed work programme/priorities. CFA to then arrange visit to be undertaken by either RPA or relevant support network.



RPA /Support Network visit

Approximate time of visit 90 minutes, discussion with groundsman and ideally a committee member on pitch issues followed by PQS testing and machinery inspection.



RPA /Support Network visit

Report to be submitted within 28 days, in the agreed standardised format. All support network reports to be sent to RPA before being sent to clubs.



Follow up visit/report

Follow up visit to be undertaken 12 months after intial visit, follow visit should only take place if the club/organsitation has undeetaken recommendations from the intial report. Follow up report to be submitted within 28 days in the agreed standardised format.

Football Foundation:

Engagement managers/Technical project manager

Any applications for machinery funding through the Football foundation must match generic specifications outlined in the PIP report. Engagement managers /Technical project manager will liaise with RPA if required and should further guidance be required.
