# SB PHOENIX



Phoenix Old Boys FC was established in 1959. Originally set up with ex-pupils of Herchel High School ( Now Herchel Grammar School.) Phoenix were members of the Old Boys Football League & affiliated to the Amateur Football Association.

The club played it's first years of football out of Godolpin Playing Fields Northampton Avenue in Slough. Then moving in early 1980s to Farnham Park playing fields Beaconsfield road which it is still it's home to this day.

The club has over the years won the Amateurs Football Combination Cup twice & is two times winner of the Slough Town Cup. The club at its peak had as many as six men's football teams under its banner. Providing football for the local youth of the surrounding area.

Phoenix left the Amateur Football Combination in 2014 joining the East Berks Football League & affiliating to the Berks & Bucks FA. After winning Division 2 of the East Berks the club took the decision to join the Thames Valley Premier League in 2018.

At the start of 2021 season it was decided to rename the club to South Bucks Phoenix FC dropping Old Boys as it was felt it was no longer relevant to club with the passing of time. The club currently has four men's football teams all playing in the Thames Valley Football League.

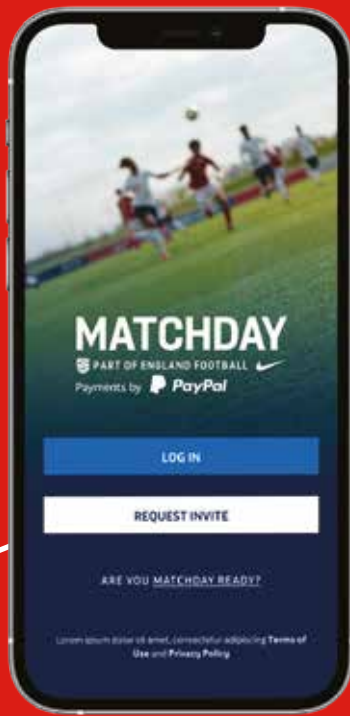

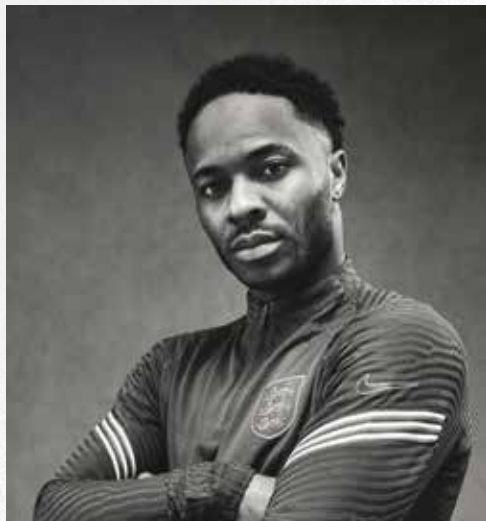
