
Play Your Part

SHINFIELD RANGERS FC



Shinfield Rangers FC was established in 1972 at the Millworth Lane Recreation Grounds in the village of Shinfield, just south of Reading. The history of how the club began is lost in time, but it is likely tied with the opening of the Junior School in 1969.

In 2013 we became one of the first Charter Standard Community Clubs in Berkshire, which opened up lots of doors. It enabled us to help obtain funding from the Football Foundation to create and develop the Ryeish Green Sports Hub and 3G pitches, that we moved most of our training into in 2017/18.

In turn, the 3G helped us grow our girls' teams through the Wildcats scheme, and disability football through BBFA's BOBiCats, for which we won a BBFA Award and another as Club of the Year in 2019. Plus Highly Commended Awards from Get Berkshire Active in 2020 for BOBiCats and for Club of the Year.

Over the past 6 years the village has grown rapidly, and consequently its football club has grown with it. With 34 teams we are no longer a small village club. That doesn't mean we have forgotten our roots, as we will always have the community at our heart.

We now have more girls' teams than we had boys each year in the first four decades of the club - a position that we are extremely proud of, especially with girls who play so brilliantly.
