City Colts strives to give children the opportunity to have fun playing a team sport whilst helping players of all abilities to develop their football skills and fitness levels together with a sense of fair play and respect. Our most famous graduate to date is Delle Alli, who started his football journey at City Colts before moving onto to MK Dons, Tottenham Hotspur and latterly Everton, also playing for England.

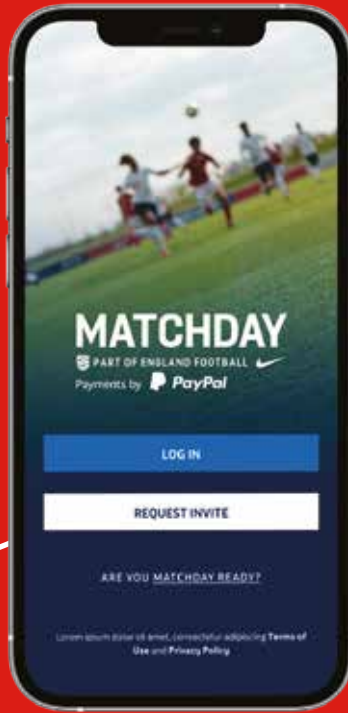

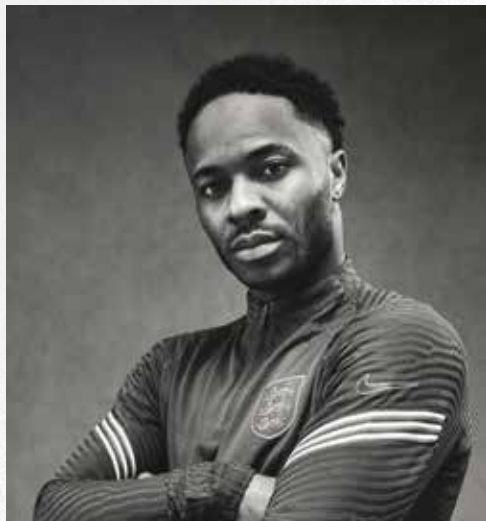
