CHILDREY FC



Childrey had a long history of football teams until in 2011 when the Men's and U18 team at the village folded.

In 2020, a new men's team was established and they set to work on bringing the facility to life again. Dug outs were built on the side of the pitch and the field had the very old goals removed. After a short time two youth teams were brought over, an U16 boys team and an U14 Girls team.

The trustees at the Childrey recreation facility invested in the pitch and with the help of a Football Foundation grant; they purchased new match and training goals. The pavilion on the site provides changing rooms for the teams, a ref changing room, toilets and a kitchen with plenty of parking.

This season only the youth teams remain as they have great support from the village. I hope that in seasons to come more youth teams will start up and take advantage of the facilities and the welcoming local area.

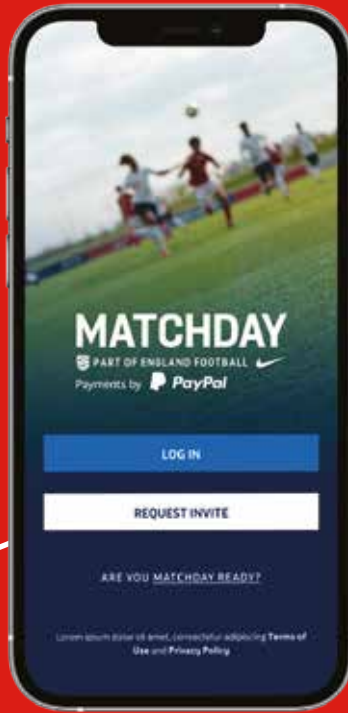
