

# Slough Local Football Partnership

## Funding Criteria



Please read the below information carefully before commencing your funding application:

- Applications are to be completed using the online form. If you are having problems with the online form please contact the Slough LFP detailing the problem you are having:

- All organisations or individuals applying for funding must either be based in Slough or be participating/delivering in Slough on a regular basis.
- Applicants will be required to upload a recent bank statement from their organisation or individual account (dependant on type of application).
- Organisations or individuals are not able to apply for funding within two years of receiving a previous grant from the Slough LFP.
- A maximum grant of £500 per organisation/project can be applied for (exceptions may be granted if justified within the application form).
- Only individuals, clubs, leagues, charities and not for profit organisations are eligible to apply.
- Any club applying must be Charter Standard, or in the process of applying for Charter Standard. Support on becoming Charter Standard can be given by the Berks & Bucks FA:

In addition, grants will also be assessed against;

- Number of participants impacted (if targeting specific groups e.g. disability this will be taken into consideration)
- Who will be impacted i.e. under-represented groups such as BAME and Female
- Sustainability and long-term impact of the funding
- Projects that are promoting new activity
