

SUPPORT PITCH ADVISORS

With the introduction of PitchPower, the volume of pitch inspections has naturally increased and the process changed significantly.

The Support Pitch Advisor (SPA) are available to provide an extra resource by being on the ground to support local clubs, and organisations.

SPA Services

Support clubs/organisations with PitchPower inspections

This is an optional paid service that can be accessed if required £100*

Support clubs/organisations with further advice following PitchPower report

This provides the option of discussing any findings and/or recommendations in more detail. SPA will document any findings to the RPA and update PitchPower report accordingly.

PITCHPOWER

PitchPower is a web app that puts the power in your hands, making it easy to sign up and carry out pitch inspections. You'll then get a detailed assessment report from the grounds management experts at the GMA with recommendations on improving the quality of your grass pitches.

- Allows you to self-assess your pitches, and record, store and update information yourself
- Significantly reduces the time it takes to receive the report compared with site visits
- Provides seasonal, ongoing advice about how to improve your pitch
- Works via a combination of photographs (site condition and soil sample) and information input
- Free to download and use

- Please ensure you use PitchPower on all your pitches if you want to apply for funding.



If applying for Football Foundation grants, you will need to submit 2 yearly inspections within the following windows;

JUL-OCT

NOV-MAR (Mandatory) APR-JUN







GRASS PITCH MAINTENANCE FUND

The Grass Pitch Maintenance Fund is a **six year tapered grant**, providing up to £2500 inc. VAT for every one of your 11 a side pitches in the first two years and scaled down over six years (£2,000 for 9 a side and £1,500 for Mini Soccer)

Your PitchPower pitch inspection will provide you with a Performace Quality Standard (PQS) per pitch. This will decide how much funding you'll be eligible for, as well as providing a list of maintenance recommendations which you'll need to carry out as part of your grant award. Grants are paid annually for six years but tapered down during that time. The amounts shown are the grant values for the first year at 100% funding.

What can the grant be spent on?

The funding provided must be used to carry out the recommendations from your PitchPower Assessment Report. These can include:

Tapered means that we'll pay a reduced percentage of the initial grant value every two years with the club making up the difference. For example, the grant awarded for an 11v11 pitch that needs enhancing would be £2,500 in year 1 and 2, £1,667 in year 3 and 4 and £833 in year 5 and 6. More details can be found in the FAQs.

SMALL GRANTS

Grants of up to £25,000 to help clubs and organisations purchase machinery and equipment recommended in their PitchPower assessment report. Machinery and equipment may be new or used and all applicants will be required to supply two like-for-like quotations for each item from different suppliers and evidence of partnership funding (grants will be provided for a maximum of 75% of the project cost).
